Honors Seal: Enrollment

Complete all requirements for Indiana High School Diploma plus...

- **Complete 4 World Language Credits**
- **Complete an additional social studies credit (for a total of 6)**
- **8 math credits (Alg 1, Alg 2, Geom, and Adv Math)**
- **Complete Chemistry then Physics or any advanced lab science course aligned to course of study (in addition to Biology)**
- **Earn a C- or higher in all courses**
- **Earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at the time of graduation**

AND ...

Honors Seal: Enrollment (continued)

- **Complete ONE of the following:**
 - **4 credits in AP and take corresponding exams**
 - **Earn 6 college credits with one from CTL**
 - **SAT score of 1250 or higher**
 - **ACT score of 26 or higher**
- OR**
- **Complete BOTH of the following:**
 - **3 college credits**
 - **2 credits in AP courses and take corresponding exams**

Honors PLUS Seal: Enrollment

Complete all of the Honors Seal for Enrollment requirements PLUS...

- **Earn a credential of value**
 - **Associate degree**
 - **Technical Certificate**
 - **Indiana College Core****
 - **AP Scholar with Distinction**
- **Complete 75 hours of work-based learning**
- **Demonstrate skills in communication, collaboration, and work ethic (more info to come!)**

Honors Seal: Employment

Complete all requirements for Indiana High School Diploma plus...

- **Complete ONE of the following:**
 - **3 courses in a CTE pathway with C or above**
 - **LHS offered pathways (Business or Agriculture)**
- **150 hours of work-based learning**
- **Demonstrate skills in communication, collaboration, and work ethic (more info to come!)**
- **Meet attendance goal (at least one school year with no more than 3 days of unexcused absences or at least 150 hours of WBL with no more than 3 UE absences)**

Honors PLUS Seal: Employment

Complete all of the Honors Seal for Employment requirements PLUS...

- **Earn a credential of value**
 - **Associate degree**
 - **Technical Certificate**
 - **Indiana College Core****
- **Complete additional work-based learning for a total of 650 hours**
- **Demonstrate skills in communication, collaboration, and work ethic (more info to come!)**

Honors Seal: Enlistment and Service

Complete all requirements for Indiana High School Diploma plus...

- **Introduction to Public Service course (more info to come!)**
- **Score at least 31 on the ASVAB**
- **Complete career exploration experience**
- **Demonstrate skills in communication, collaboration, and work ethic through external verification with current military personnel, veterans, or other public safety professionals (more info to come!)**
- **Meet attendance goal (at least one school year with no more than 3 days of unexcused absences or at least 150 hours of WBL with no more than 3 UE absences)**

Honors PLUS Seal: Enlistment and Service

Complete all of the Honors Seal for Employment requirements PLUS...

- **Complete one of the following:**
 - **Achieve a 50 or higher on the ASVAB**
 - **Enrollment in ROTC at the collegiate level**
 - **Acceptance into a service academy**
- **Complete one of the following:**
 - **At least 100 hours of public service**
 - **Hold a leadership role in a co/extracurricular activity**
 - **Completion of two seasons of a team-based physical sport or activity**

21st Century Scholars

- Based on family's financial need
- Enrollment Process - can apply/automatic enrollment by state if free/reduced lunch
- Application must be completed by June 30 of 8th grade year
- Confirm before applying that the student was not automatically enrolled
- Pays for up to 4 years of college tuition at a public university in Indiana
- Requirements to earn scholarship:
 - Complete Scholar Success Program, which includes Scholar Success activities at each grade level in high school to help you plan, prepare, and pay for college
 - Apply for admission into an eligible Indiana college and apply for FAFSA
 - Graduate with a minimum Core 40 diploma and GPA of 2.5 or higher
 - Not use illegal drugs, commit a crime, delinquent act, or consume alcohol

What Else

- **Semester grades are placed on high school transcript**
 - **If you are in a class for high school credit now, you are already starting your high school transcript (Health, Band, Intro to Ag, PE)**
 - **GPA is based on semester grades only**
 - **GPA can affect work, scholarships, college entrance, military, athletics, and extracurricular activities**
- **Challenge yourself by choosing rigorous courses**
- **Get involved at school & in the community**
- **Attendance matters!**
- **Check your email and Harmony daily**

- **You will be planning for your ENTIRE 9th grade school year**
- **Complete the scheduling worksheet prior to online registration**
 - **Take home for parent approval and guidance**
- **Make sure you have a backup schedule should a class be closed when you register online**
