FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. When will the credit be posted to the student's transcript? At the end of the stated Semester.
2. Can a lay coach (non-teacher) still be the facilitator of this course? Yes, since the grade is being assigned by a licensed Physical Education teacher.
3. Does ASPE count as a class toward IHSAA eligibility? No, Physical education credit earned by participation on an athletic team, may not count toward academic eligibility.
