# Academic/Technical Honors

- o Check your progress
- o Do not get senioritis

# SAT/ACT Tests

- o Sign up as early as possible to take tests.
- o [www.collegeboard.org](http://www.collegeboard.org) for SAT
- o [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org) for ACT
- o Check admission requirements of your college choices
- o Prepare for the tests
- o Make sure to send scores directly to the colleges you are applying to
- o Fee waivers are available for those that qualify

# Applications

- Apply early as most have a November 1 deadline to qualify for scholarships
- Check your college choices weekly for deadlines
- Students must inform me of what materials I need to send to the colleges they have applied to. Colleges do NOT send requests. This can be letters of recommendation, transcripts, school report.

# Requesting Transcripts

- o You can also go directly to [www.parchment.com](http://www.parchment.com)
- o Set up an account and request transcripts be sent.
- o Only way transcript will be sent unless specified by the college
- o Office will not print transcripts/must request through Parchment

# Select a College

- o College Visit (pick up form in the office)
- o Make a Commitment and notify other schools you applied to of your acceptance
- o Continue to check deadlines for items such as housing, tuition, scholarships, etc...

# Requesting Dual Credit Transcripts

- o High school transcript will show which University offered the Dual Credit
- o Most have an online request section.
- o I cannot request a college transcript and a high school transcript will not be accepted as proof of the dual credit.

# FAFSA/Financial Aid

- o FAFSA Completion Night to be determined
- o FAFSA opens October 1
