Academic/Technical Honors

SAT/ACT Tests

- o Sign up as early as possible to take tests.
- o www.collegeboard.org for SAT
- o www.actstudent.org for ACT
- o Check admission requirements of your college choices
- o Prepare for the tests
- o Make sure to send scores directly to the colleges you are applying to if required
- o Fee waivers are available for those that qualify

Applications

- o Apply early as most have a November 1 deadline to qualify for scholarships
- o Check your college choices weekly for deadlines
- o Students must inform me of what materials I need to send to the colleges they have applied to. Colleges do NOT send requests. This can be letters of recommendation, transcripts, school report.

Requesting Transcripts

- o You can also go directly to www.parchment.com
- o Set up an account and request transcripts be sent.
- o Only way transcript will be sent unless specified by the college
- o Office will not print transcripts/must request through Parchment

Scholarships

- o Weekly scholarship list will be emailed at the end of each week and also posted on my webpage which is...

- o Help available after school or during study hall. Just let me know ahead of time
- o I will update the list as scholarships become available.

- o Lilly Scholarship opens on August 10 and closes on September 30 at 4PM.
- o The Universal Application opens on November 8 and will close January 20 @4:00 PM

Select a College

- o College Visit (pick up form in the office)
- o Make a Commitment and notify other schools you applied to of your acceptance
- o Continue to check deadlines for items such as housing, tuition, scholarships, etc...

Requesting Dual Credit Transcripts

- o High school transcript will show which University offered the Dual Credit
- o Most have an online request section.
- o I cannot request a college transcript and a high school transcript will not be accepted as proof of the dual credit.

FAFSA/Financial Aid

- o FAFSA Completion Night will be January 8, 2024 from 6-8.
- o FAFSA opens December for the 2024-25 award year and will resume October 1 for the 2025-26 award year

Athletes

- o Be sure to be talking with your coaches or Mr. Payne if college sports is something you are intending to play.
- o I have included some NCAA and NAIA resources for students and parents on my website
- o Any questions be sure to set up a meeting with Mr. Payne and myself

Military/Workforce

- o Military- there are checks that I have to complete for academics. It is critical that you complete and pass courses
- o Workforce- they do ask for items like diploma type, graduation date, GPA, etc...
